

New! Abraxas I Intensive Residential Program

Highlights

- 32 bed, open residential program providing staff secure / intensive programming
- Focuses primarily on delinquency issues, criminal behavior and corresponding treatment issues
- Cognitive behavioral model with a strong emphasis on Aggression Replacement Training and Balanced and Restorative Justice
- Primary counselors provide individual, group and family counseling and implement individualized treatment plans identifying core treatment issues and clinical action steps
- Master's level clinicians assist primary counselors in the treatment process and provide individual counseling to youth on a case-by-case basis
- Staff to client ratio is 1:4
- Variable lengths of stay

Admissions Criteria

- Delinquent and/or dependent male adolescents between the ages of 14 to 18
- History of significant aggression and/or violent behavior
- History of habitual criminal activity
- IQ of 70 or above (others will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis)

Clinical

- Six phase clinical system provides clear and obtainable treatment objectives to assist youth in navigating through their individual treatment goals
- Multiple clinical assessments are completed with each youth in order to assist in identifying individualized treatment issues
- Psychological and psychiatric services are available

Workforce Development

- Academic and Career & Technical Education
- High school education licensed by the Pennsylvania Department of Education
- Special Education services
- Diploma and GED tracks
- Vocational programming offered in seven different fields

Education

- Work readiness program as well as multiple restitution programs that provide clients the opportunity to earn stipends to pay owed restitution to their authorizing agencies
