- Abraxas Ohio will leverage the expertise and experience of the four other Abraxas SO programs across the Division who have been operating this service for the past 15 years

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

- Males between the ages of 12 to 18 years old
- IQ of 70 or above; under 70 will be considered on an individual basis
- History of sexual offending or sexually abusive behavior
- Adjudicated dependent
- Adjudicated delinquent offenders that can safely and effectively be managed and treated in an open residential setting to be determined by the clinical director and the program director

CLINICAL SERVICES

- Individual Therapy is provided by a LSW or LPC
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy is the core approach
- Behavior Change Programming, emphasizing boundary setting and trial and error learning
- Positive Peer Culture/Modified Therapeutic Community, which empowers youth to assume responsibility and ownership in the treatment process
- Family counseling
- Psychiatric evaluation and risk assessment conducted with each client
